**You can work on your own in the smaller areas or participate in a mock trial to give you good practice for the ISDA Sheepdog trial in Tingley planned for November. It is a great chance to work your dog in a new location and on different sheep. We will have polypays, cheviots and hair sheep available to work (some of the sheep are more suited for inexperienced dogs than others).**

**Over the lunch hour we will have our annual meeting and awards for 2016 points. There will be a big pot of chili, plus club members are encouraged to bring sides, beverages or desserts to share. Bring lawnchairs and your dogs!**

**Non-members are welcomed to join in the fun. Anyone interested in joining as a member can do so as well.**

*Directions from I-35: Take Exit #65 off of I-35 and go east about 1 mile. As you come to the edge of the town of Cumming, you will cross a bike trail. Turn right immediately after the bike trail on to S44th pl (it is gravel) go about 1/2 to 2/3 of a mile until the road comes to a "T", take a right and travel about 2 miles. You will see Blue Flagg Marsh on the left and then cross the bike trail again. Start to go up the hill after the bike trail. It will be the first driveway to the right. You cannot see the house from the road. The arena and round pen are in the back of the property. You will have to park by the house and walk around to the back area. There is a morton building that you can drop off food at behind the house. The 15 acre field is directly across the road from the driveway.*
